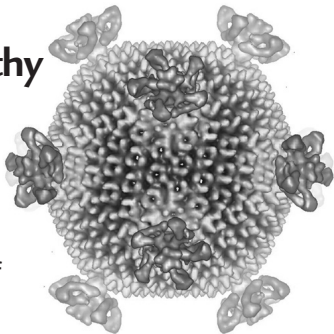


MSU is studying viruses that can make you healthy

Huh?!

Only a very small fraction of viruses cause disease in humans. Viruses have been found in every corner of the world: the bottom of the ocean, caves two miles below the surface, and in the hot springs of Yellowstone National Park.

Viruses are the original nanorobots and can perform a lot of tasks, including self-assembly and tricking a cell into letting them inside. Through research, MSU scientists might someday use viruses to kill cancer cells or build a computer so small that you need a microscope to see it.
